

ORDINANCE NO. 185442

An ordinance amending Section 8.231 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code to reduce the membership of the Innovation and Performance Commission to nine members and to provide authority to the Mayor to appoint three members and to the President of the City Council to appoint six members from nominations submitted by the chairs of three committees of the City Council.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES  
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Section 8.231 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code is amended in its entirety to read as follows:

**Sec. 8.231. Membership.**

The Commission shall consist of nine members. The Mayor shall appoint three members. The Council President shall appoint six members from nominations submitted by the Chairs of the Budget and Finance Committee (2 nominations), the Personnel and Animal Welfare Committee (2 nominations), and the Public Works and Gang Reduction Committee (2 nominations) of the City Council. Each Mayoral and Council President appointment shall be subject to confirmation by the Council by majority vote. A member appointed by the Mayor may be removed by the Mayor. A member appointed by the Council President may be removed by the President subject to approval by the Council by majority vote.

Sec. 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.


