

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to technology assessments for the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) and the Los Angeles Fire Department (LAFD).

Recommendation for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Englander - Buscaino):

INSTRUCT the Information Technology Agency (ITA), with the assistance of the LAPD and the LAFD, to conduct a comprehensive technology assessment of the needs of the LAPD and LAFD in 45 days, with the assessment detailing and prioritizing the upgrades, tools and equipment necessary to ensure that the departments can effectively and efficiently address the public safety needs of residents.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At a regular meeting held on October 25, 2017, the Public Safety Committee considered Motion (Englander - Buscaino) regarding technology assessment of the LAPD and LAFD. Representatives from the ITA and LAPD provided the Committee with information regarding the current technology. After a brief discussion and an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended to approve the Motion with an amendment for the departments to report back in 45 days. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
