

**BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE REPORT** relative to the necessary resources to manage traffic and public safety issues around the Hollywood Sign and adjacent neighborhoods.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Ryu - Krekorian):

INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT), Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD), and Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP) to develop and submit a budget request for consideration as part of the 2018-19 Mayor's Proposed Budget, identifying needed resources to adequately manage traffic and public safety issues around the Hollywood Sign and in adjacent neighborhoods.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

**SUMMARY**

At its regular meeting held on November 27, 2017, the Budget and Finance Committee considered Motion (Ryu - Krekorian) relative to an instruction to the LADOT, LAPD, and RAP to develop and submit a budget request for consideration as part of the 2018-19 Mayor's Proposed Budget, identifying needed resources to adequately manage traffic and public safety issues around the Hollywood Sign and in adjacent neighborhoods. The Motion states that that Council District 4 has been using discretionary funds to provide additional parking in this area and for LAPD oversight, and that this is not an appropriate source of funds in the long-term and that a stable, non-discretionary source of funding is needed.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee approved the recommendation in the Motion. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
