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TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the Fiscal Year (FY) 2016-17 report to City Council on the status of the Mobile Source Air Pollution Reduction Trust Fund.

Recommendation for Council action:

NOTE and FILE the September 30, 2017 Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) report relative to the FY 2016-17 report to City Council on the status of the Mobile Source Air Pollution Reduction Trust Fund pursuant to Ordinance No. 181196.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Not applicable.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On December 13, 2017, your Committee considered a September 30, 2017 LADOT report relative to the FY 2016-17 report to City Council on the status of the Mobile Source Air Pollution Reduction Trust Fund pursuant to Ordinance No. 181196. According to the LADOT, the City receives State funds per Assembly Bill 2766 (AB 2766) and those funds are deposited into the Trust Fund. In accordance with Ordinance No. 181196, the administration of the Trust Fund was transferred to the LADOT on July 1, 2010 and therefore, as the Trust Fund Administrator, the LADOT is required to provide an annual report to the City Council describing the amount and purpose of receipts to and expenditures from the Trust Fund following the end of each fiscal year. This report complies with that requirement provided by the Ordinance and details the Trust Fund revenues and expenditures for the period of July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017 (FY 2017). Also, as Trust Fund Administrator, the LADOT is also required to report to the South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) on the emissions reductions achieved from programs funded through AB 2766 funds. In accordance with that requirement, LADOT will submit the emission reduction report for FY 2017 to SCAQMD by February 2, 2018.

After further consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to note and file the September 30, 2017 LADOT report. This report is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
