## MOTION

The Sunshine Canyon Community Amenities Trust Fund provides funds for financing community amenities within the City of Los Angeles, within five miles of the Sunshine Canyon landfill.

Valley Relics Museum is a non-profit organization that is coordinating efforts to hold the "Making Movies That Matter" Youth Film Festival at the Valley Performing Arts Center on the Cal State University of Northridge campus. Funds are required to utilize the Arts Center for the film festival. The total cost of the film festival is \$170,000 and out of the 32 schools participating in the event, 10 of them are located within the radius requirement of Sunshine Canyon Landfill which is sufficient enough participation to justify a portion of the funding being appropriated from this source. Sufficient funds are available in the Sunshine Canyon Community Amenities Trust Fund which could be used for this purpose.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council RESOLVE that \$22,721 in the Sunshine Canyon Community Amenities Trust Fund No. 699-14 be allocated / appropriated to Valley Relics Museum in order to secure the Valley Performing Arts Center as the venue for the "Making Movies That Matter" youth film festival.

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Clerk be directed to prepare and process the necessary documents(s) with, and/or payment(s) to Valley Relics Museum or any other agency or organization, as appropriate, in the above amount, from the above source, and for the above purposes, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form, if needed; and that, if needed, the Councilmember of the Twelfth District be authorized to execute any such documents on behalf of the City.

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Clerk be authorized to make any technical corrections or clarifications to the above fund transfer instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this motion.
