Dear Councilmembers Buscaino and Harris-Dawson:

On September 11, 2018, our Board voted 8-0-1 support the City Council's position of opposition to S. 3157-115<sup>th</sup> Congress (Thune), the STREAMLINE Small Cell Deployment Act, which would amend Section 332(c) of the Communications Act of 1934 to restrict the timeframe for City approval of small personal wireless service facilities and would restrict the setting of fees for permits for small personal wireless facilities such that they would not adequately reflect the value of the Los Angeles market to wireless carriers.

We also note that S. 3157 is similar to a California bill (SB 649) which would have created a state mandated system of cell towers and eliminated local review and safety oversight. SB 649 was opposed by 300 cities, 47 counties and over 100 community, planning, health, environment, and justice organizations. SB 649 was vetoed by Governor Jerry Brown on October 15, 2017.
