ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2017-18 State Legislative Program, SUPPORT for Proposition 1 which places a \$4 billion General Obligation Bond on the November 2018 ballot to fund affordable housing programs and the veteran homeownership program, and Proposition 2 which would build and rehabilitate housing for those with mental illness who are homeless or at risk of being homeless.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: None submitted by the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA). The City Administrative Officer has not completed a financial analysis if this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At a special meeting held on August 17, 2018, the Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered Resolution (Wesson - Cedillo), and a report from the CLA, relative to including in the City's 2017-18 State Legislative Program, support for for Veterans and Affordable Housing Act of 2018 (Proposition 1) that places a \$4 billion General Obligation Bond on the November 2018 ballot to fund affordable housing programs and the veterans homeownership program; and the No Place Like Home Act of 2018 (Proposition 2) which would build and rehabilitate housing for those with mental illness who are homeless or at risk of being homeless. The CLA report, attached to the Council file, provides additional background information a summary of the Resolution.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council adopt the accompanying Resolution. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
