

RULES, ELECTIONS, AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE
REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to establishing the City's position regarding Proposition 6.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Blumenfield - Buscaino - Bonin - Krekorian - Price), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2017-18 State Legislative Program, OPPOSITION to Proposition 6, which would repeal SB 1, the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017, and eliminate revenue created under SB 1 and reduce funding for highway and road improvement, maintenance, repairs, and for transit programs.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA). The City Administrative Officer has not completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: Yes.

SUMMARY

At a special meeting held on October 10, 2018, the Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered Resolution (Blumenfield - Buscaino - Bonin - Krekorian - Price) and a CLA report relative to establishing the City's position regarding Proposition 6, which would repeal SB 1, the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017. The CLA reports that if Proposition 6, currently on the November 6, 2018 ballot, is approved by the majority of voters, it would eliminate the revenue created under SB 1, reducing funding for highway and road maintenance and repairs and transit programs. Proposition 6 would also restrict the State Legislature's ability to address these issues in the future through revenue enhancements.

After consideration, and after providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that the Council adopt the accompanying Resolution. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
