Box 457 Sun Valley, CA 91353-0457 818-76-SVANC (767-8262) cindy.sower@svanc.com On the issue of CF#18-0002-S125, we are: 16 For 0 Against Summary: At the General Board meeting of the Sun Valley Area Neighborhood Council (SVANC) held on November 13, 2018, the board voted to Support CF#18-0002-S125 regarding LA City Council's resolution in opposition to the Refined SR14 alignment for the California High Speed Rail Authority's Palmdale-to-Burbank project segment, and any other alignments that would cross any natural segments of the Los Angeles River and its tributaries, including the Big Tujunga Wash & the Pacoima Wash, other foothill canyons, the Hansen Spreading Grounds, or any areas at or above grade, trenched or cut-and-cover. SVANC continues to join with other communities in the North East San Fernando Valley who believe more needs to be done to protect our homes, businesses and open & natural areas from the negative impacts of Refined SR-14, Refined E1, and Refined E2 high speed train routes. By vote on Nov. 13th, we are hereby opposed to all of these routes, including the entire California High Speed Rail project.
