RULES, ELECTIONS, AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to establishing the City's position regarding AB 1744 (McCarty) which would amend the Adult Use of Marijuana Act (AUMA) regarding funding for educational programs and for schools to establish those programs.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Ryu - Martinez), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2017-18 State Legislative Program, SUPPORT for AB 1744 (McCarty) which would amend AUMA to specify that programs including the After School Education and Safety Program are eligible to receive funding under AUMA and encourage schools that establish these programs to apply for funding.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA). The City Administrative Officer has not completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At a special meeting held on May 23, 2018, the Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered Resolution (Ryu - Martinez) and a report from the CLA relative to establishing the City's position regarding AB 1744 (McCarty), which would amend the AUMA to specify that programs including the After School Education and Safety Program are eligible to receive funding under AUMA and encourage schools that establish these programs to apply for funding. The CLA report, attached to the Council file, provides additional background information and a summary of the Resolution.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council adopt the accompanying Resolution. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
