Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Koretz - Martinez - Rodriguez - Wesson - Harris-Dawson), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2017-18 State Legislative Program, SPONSORSHIP and SUPPORT of AB 2342 (Burke), which would require health care service plans, health insurers, and the California Department of Health Care Services to cover screening, genetic counseling, and testing for Breast Cancer susceptibility (BRCA) gene mutations in women who have not been diagnosed with BRCA-related cancer and do not have any signs for symptoms of the disease, but who may have an increased risk based on one or more specific family history risk factors.
