ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2017-18 State Legislative Program, SUPPORT for AB 2005 (Santiago) which would require a police or sheriffs department to forward reports of known or suspected child abuse or severe neglect, that are investigated and determined to be substantiated, to the California Department of Justice for inclusion in the Child Abuse Central Index.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: None submitted by the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA). The City Administrative Officer has not completed a financial analysis of this report.

SUMMARY

At a special meeting held on August 17, 2018, the Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered a CLA report and Resolution relative to establishing the City's position regarding AB 2005 (Santiago), which would require a police or sheriffs department to forward reports of known or suspected child abuse or severe neglect, that are investigated and determined to be substantiated, to the California Department of Justice for inclusion in the Child Abuse Central Index. The CLA report and Resolution, attached to the Council file, provide additional background information.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council adopt the accompanying Resolution. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
