Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2017-18 State Legislative Program, SUPPORT for SB 1281 (Stern).

SUMMARY

At a special meeting held on August 17, 2018, the Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered a CLA report and Resolution relative to establishing the City's position regarding SB 1281 (Stern), which would prohibit the destruction of a sealed juvenile record of an individual if the offense in that record has made the person subject to a firearm restriction until he or she turns 33 years of age, and would allow a prosecutor or the California Department of Justice to access, inspect, or utilize these records for the enforcement of firearm restrictions. The CLA Report and Resolution, attached to the Council file, provide additional background information.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council adopt the accompanying Resolution. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
