Detectives believe that a reward may compel members of the public to provide information on the identity of the person or persons responsible for this crime. The person or persons responsible for this crime represent an ongoing threat to the safety of the people of Los Angeles. Unless withdrawn or void by City Council action, this offer of reward shall terminate on, and have no effect after, NOVEMBER 15, 2019.
