When officers arrived on scene they found 27-year old Antonio Wilson, who had been shot multiple times, laying in the middle of a parking lot. Mr. Wilson was transported to the hospital, where he succumbed to his injuries. So far, the investigation has revealed that Mr. Wilson was shot by gang members from the area which Mr. Wilson was walking. Detectives are continuing to investigate this crime, but have been unable to identify a suspect of suspects. Detectives believe that a reward may compel members of the public to provide information on the identity of the person or persons responsible for this crime. The person or persons responsible for this crime represent an ongoing threat to the safety of the people of Los Angeles. Unless withdrawn or paid by City Council action, this offer of reward shall terminate on, and have no effect after JANUARY 4, 2019.
