The City of Los Angeles offers a reward payable at the discretion of the City Council to one or more persons in the sum or sums up to an aggregate maximum total sum of \$50,000 for information leading to the identification and apprehension of the person or persons responsible for the DEATH OF PEDRO HERNANDEZ, in the City of Los Angeles. On Sunday, September 2, 2018, Pedro Hernandez was at a party in the 14500 block of Tyler Street in Sylmar. At approximately 1:00 a.m., a fight broke out among a number of partygoers and Mr. Hernandez attempted to intervene. During this altercation, a number of suspects began shooting, and one round struck Mr. Hernandez. Mr. Hernandez was transported to a local hospital, where he succumbed to his injuries. Detectives are continuing to investigate this crime, but have not been able to identify the suspects. Detectives believe a reward may compel members of the public to provide information on the person responsible for this crime. The person or persons responsible for this crime represent an ongoing threat to the safety of the people of Los Angeles. Unless withdrawn or paid by City Council action, this offer of reward shall terminate on, and have no effect after, MAY 30, 2019.

The provisions of payment and all other considerations shall be governed by Chapter 12 of Division 19 of the LAAC Code, as amended by Ordinance Nos. 158157 and 166666. This offer shall be given upon the condition that all claimants provide continued cooperation within the criminal justice system relative to this case and is not available to public officers or employees of the City, their families, persons in law enforcement or persons whose misconduct prompted this reward.
