Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Englander - Koretz):

INSTRUCT Chief Legislative Analyst to work with the Personnel Department, with the assistance of the City Attorney, to present options for increased support for children of LODD to become LAPD and/or LAFD members, and report to the Public Safety Committee within 30 days with options.
