Pursuant to City Council's request, this Office transmitted, on January 31, 2019, a draft ordinance adding a new Chapter 32 to Division 22 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code establishing a Civil and Human Rights Commission and Executive Director.

After consideration of the matter, the City Council, on April 17, 2019, requested this Office revise the draft ordinance such that the Civil and Human Rights Commission shall be comprised of seven members appointed by the Mayor and to allow the Commission to create regulations to implement the ordinance.

Pursuant to that request, we present the enclosed revised draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality.
