PUBLIC SAFETY

On January 30, 2018 at approximately 4:30PM, Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department deputies were observed dropping off an individual on the curb of West 25th Street in San Pedro, CA, and promptly leaving the area. The individual displayed characteristics of a person who may be experiencing homelessness and mental illness.

Video footage of the incident was captured by a concerned citizen who then notified the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD). The video is available to view here: http://bit.lv/2DQg75e

LAPD responded to the radio call per Department policy. It was determined by LAPD that a warrant was out for this individual's arrest. The individual is now booked at the 77th jail.

Given the evidence, a robust investigation is warranted. If substantiated, the actions of the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department jeopardized the safety of Los Angeles residents and resulted in an additional cost to Los Angeles' taxpayers.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department be REQUESTED to conduct a thorough investigation of the incident that occured on January 30, 2018 and present their findings to the City Council.

I FURTHER MOVE that the CAO, with the assistance of LAPD and LAFD, be DIRECTED to present on the cost incurred by the City in response to the call for service.
