Pursuant to your request, this Office previously prepared and transmitted for your consideration a draft ordinance to allow a person who finds a lost or stray dog or cat to provide home care for a temporary period of time not to exceed 30 days. On June 25, 2019, the City Council requested this Office to revise the draft ordinance to provide notification requirements, waive adoption fees, and minimize the City's liability. The revised draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality, reflects the changes requested by City Council with additional input and guidance from the General Manager of the Department of Animal Services (Department).
