Honorable Members:

Pursuant to your request, this Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality. As the local Certified Unified Program Agency (CUPA), the Los Angeles Fire Department is responsible for enforcing regulatory standards that are administered by the California Environmental Protection Agency and intended to protect the public from hazardous waste and hazardous materials. Certain regulated businesses are required to file an annual Hazardous Material Business Plan. The draft ordinance establishes a late submission penalty in order to increase compliance with the annual Hazardous Materials Business Plan filing requirement.


Council Rule 38 Referral
