

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to an offer to dedicate easement for street, sidewalk and alley purposed on the southeasterly line of Palms Boulevard, the northeasterly line of Penmar Avenue and the northwest line of the alley southeast of Palms Boulevard (Right-of-Way No. 36000-10094).

Recommendations for Council action:

1. ACCEPT the petitioner's offer to dedicate easement for street, sidewalk and alley purposed on the southeasterly line of Palms Boulevard, the northeasterly line of Penmar Avenue and the northwest line of the alley southeast of Palms Boulevard, substantially shown on the Exhibit Map of the Bureau of Engineering (BOE) report dated April 12, 2018 (attached to the Council file).
2. AUTHORIZE the Board of Public Works to acquire the dedication.
3. INSTRUCT the City Clerk to forward a copy of the Council action of this project, to the Real Estate Division of the BOE for processing.



Summary:

At a regular meeting held on October 3, 2018, the Public Safety Committee considered a BOE report regarding an offer to dedicate easement for street, sidewalk and alley purposed on the southeasterly line of Palms Boulevard, the northeasterly line of Penmar Avenue and the northwest line of the alley southeast of Palms Boulevard. After an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended on consent to approve the recommendations in the BOE report. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
