HOMELESSNESS AND POVERTY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the potential use of City-owned property located at 682 South Vermont Avenue (Lot 691) for development as a crisis and bridge housing facility.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Wesson - Harris-Dawson):

- INSTRUCT the City Administrative Officer (CAO), with the assistance of the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), the Bureau of Engineering, Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority, and any other affected City stakeholders, to evaluate the City-owned Los Angeles Department of Transportation Parking Lot located at 682 South Vermont Avenue (Lot 691) to determine if the property is suitable for development as a crisis and bridge housing facility.
- INSTRUCT the City Homeless Coordinator to coordinate with the Los Angeles County to identify funds for operations at this site, including, but not limited to County Measure H revenue, if the property is determined to be suitable for development as crisis and bridge housing facility.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: Neither the CAO nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On May 22, 2018, the Homelessness and Poverty Committee considered Motion (Wesson - Harris-Dawson) relative to the determination if the City-owned property located at 682 South Vermont Avenue (Lot 691) is suitable for development as a crisis and bridge housing facility.

After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to approve Motion (Wesson - Harris-Dawson). The matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
