ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION dated November 8, 2018 to de-designate the former Medical Services Office of the Employment Services Division of the Department of Water and Power (DWP), now known as Occupational Health Services of the Human Resources Division of the DWP as a health care component of the hybrid covered entity City of Los Angeles pursuant to HIPAA.
