## Honorable Members:

As requested by the City Council, this Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality. The Clerk's Office has requested the ordinance amendment to allow the Business Improvement District Trust Fund (Fund) to be used for a greater array of services and activities to meet the growing needs of the City's Business Improvement District (BID) program. The draft ordinance amends Section 5.490 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code to expand the purpose of the Fund to pay for services and activities that directly support the BID program. The expanded activities would include personnel support, system upgrades, BID audits, receipt and disbursement of recovery costs, payment of general benefit, and other services and activities that directly enhance the BID program. A portion of the Fund will be disbursed to the Schedule 29 account to be used to pay a portion of the salaries of City BID staff thereby offsetting the general fund obligation to pay those salaries.
