MOTIO NOMELESSNESS AND POVERTY

In the City of Los Angeles, homeless residents often lack sufficient space to store their belongings during the day. The lack of voluntary storage for homeless residents can create significant issues for these individuals when they are seeking services and/or housing. Lack of storage also creates significant public health and safety concerns in the City's public right-of-way.

In an effort to find a suitable storage location in Council District 12, it is important that each potential location be investigated. The parcels owned by Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA) located at the North East corner and South East corner of Hayvenhurst Place and Schoenborn Street in North Hills should be investigated by the City in order to determine if either or both are viable locations for a voluntary homeless storage facility. The assessor parcel numbers (APN) for the parcels are 2689015014 and 2689002908 respectively.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council instruct the City Administrative Officer with the assistance of the Chief Legislative Analyst, and City Attorney to evaluate the LAWA owned parcels located at 8300 N. Hayvenhurst Place, APN's 22689015014 and 2689002908 in North Hills and determine the viability of the sites for utilization as a storage facility for the homeless that may include the use of temporary modular offices, storage containers and/or vehicles which accommodate bins or other containers.
