Comments for Public Posting: To whom it may concern: Regarding deciding a uniform minimum age for the Neighborhood Councils: If the city is going to mandate minors on the council will the city also please mandate back ground checks with finger printing for all people serving on the councils and their committees. In our public schools minors are under the direct supervision of employees who have had background checks and finger printing as a condition of employment, as are walk on coaches. In hospitals/health care facilities minors are under the care of employees who also have had background checks and finger printing as a condition of employment. Will Neighborhood Council members be responsible for these minors? What if they don't show up or leave early do we need to contact their parents to ensure they are at home? I believe the city would be assuming a huge risk here. Will the parents have to sign a release form holding the city and the NC harmless? Will the parents have to provide transportation? Is walking or a bus ride after ten pm safe? Can these minors be transported in NC members private vehicles? If an accident occurs will the city assume responsibility since this could be council business to ensure the minor arrives safely at home? Most meetings are held during the week in the evenings up to midnight, considering our graduation rate should we be using a high schooler's precious time for this time of activity? As any board member will tell you full participation on any NC turns into full time jobs for many, Time commitments at orientation are stated as 10-20+ hours a week minimum. Since all board and committee meetings are free, ADA compliant and open to the public there is no reason why an interested minor cannot already participate with any given NC or it's committees.
