

HEALTH, EDUCATION, NEIGHBORHOODS, PARKS, ARTS, AND RIVER COMMITTEE  
REPORT relative to the Neighborhood Council system reforms.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. REQUEST the City Attorney, working with the Department of Neighborhood Empowerment (DONE) and the City Clerk, to report on a draft Ordinance to implement a uniform minimum age for voting in Neighborhood Council elections and for Neighborhood Council board members, and the impact of such an Ordinance on the Neighborhood Council structural system.
2. NOTE and FILE the reports from DONE dated, August 20, 2019, and City Clerk, dated April 15, 2019, relative to Neighborhood Council system reforms.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On August 28, 2019, the Health, Education, Neighborhoods, Parks, Arts, and River Committee considered an August 8, 2019 report relative to the Neighborhood Council system reforms. The reports attached to the Council file, includes some background on the matter. After an opportunity for public comment was held, the Committee moved to approve the recommendations, as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the City Council for its consideration.
