**RESPONSE TO COUNCIL FILE 18-0485 RELATIVE TO IDENTIFYING THE  
INVENTORY OF ALL SINGLE STALL RESTROOMS**

The State of California, through AB 1732 (Ting), requires all businesses and government agencies to identify single-user restroom facilities as all-gender facilities. The Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP) has participated in the conversion of single stall restrooms to all-gender as part of an ongoing effort within the City of Los Angeles.

Thereafter, on May 30, 2018 the City Council adopted a motion requesting the RAP and all City Departments to provide a report identifying the inventory of all single-stall restrooms in owned and leased facilities and an implementation plan with budgetary components for converting these restrooms to all-gender restroom facilities.

Our RAP Facilities Inventory and Breakdown is as follows:

Currently, there are 8 restrooms that comply with AB1732:

- Harbor Highlands Recreation Center (2)
- Richie Valens Recreation Center (2)
- North Weddington Recreation Center (2)
- Gladys Park (2)

Future projects (to be completed within the next year) include:

- Albion Park (2)
- Ord and Yale Park (2)
- East Wilmington Park (2)
- El Sereno Recreation Center (2)



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There are approximately 597 remaining single-stall restrooms which can be converted to an all-gender restroom facility by installing proper signage designating them as such. The estimated cost for installation of signs in compliance with AB1732 for all 597 single use toilet facilities is \$144,176.00 including cost of signs and labor.

Pending allocated funding, Recreation and Parks will create an implementation plan for installation of the signs for the 597 restrooms throughout the department.
