MOTION

I HEREBY MOVE that the Council ADOPT the following recommendations of the City Attorney in order to effect settlement in the case entitled <u>San Regis</u>, <u>LLC v. City of Los Angeles</u>, <u>et al.</u>, Los Angeles Superior Court Case No. BC637630 (this matter involves the proposed settlement of pending litigation over the remaining term of a regulatory agreement protecting 78 units of affordable housing at 15454-15460 Sherman Way [the Project] in Los Angeles, Council District 6):

- 1. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney to settle the above-entitled matter along the following proposed terms:
 - a. San Regis, LLC will issue new bonds for the Project, the proceeds of which will go towards: (a) repairs and improvements on the project, and (b) approximately \$23 million of which will refund the remaining balance on the 2001 bonds.
 - b. San Regis will authorize a new, 55-year Regulatory Agreement to be placed on the Project, which would continue to restrict the same 78 units until approximately 2073.
 - c. The California Housing Finance Agency (CalHFA) will be the issuing authority for the new bonds.
- 2. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney, or designee, to execute all documents necessary to implement the proposed Settlement Agreement.

This matter was recommended for approval by the Budget and Finance Committee (Englander – Blumenfield – Bonin: "Yes") at its meeting on August 13, 2018, in Closed Session as permitted by Government Code Section 54956.9(d)(1).
