Initiation of Vacation Proceedings - 21st Street Southerly of Washington Boulevard from Maple Avenue to its Northwesterly Terminus - VAC - E1401212R (Re-application)

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- A. That upon adoption of this report, the vacation proceeding to vacate 21st Street southerly of Washington Boulevard from Maple Avenue to its northwesterly terminus as shown on Exhibit A, be initiated pursuant to California Streets and Highways Code, Division 9, Part 3, Public Streets, Highways and Service Easements Vacation Law.
- B. That the Bureau of Engineering be directed to process this vacation request under Council File No. 02-1979, Engineering Work Order No. E1401212.
- C. That the Bureau of Engineering be directed to investigate the feasibility of this vacation request.
- D. That the Bureau of Engineering present its report regarding the feasibility of vacating the requested area to the Public Safety Committee.
- E. That upon consideration and approval by the Public Safety Committee, the City Clerk be directed to coordinate with the Chair, subject to the concurrence of the Council President and schedule this request for the City Council's consideration at the appropriate time consistent with the public hearing requirement under California Street and Highways Code Section 8320.
