

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to initiating vacation proceedings for 21st Street southerly of Washington Boulevard from Maple Avenue to its northwesterly terminus (No. VAC-E1401212R) (re-application).

Recommendations for Council action:

1. FIND that upon adoption of this report, the vacation proceeding to vacate 21st Street southerly of Washington Boulevard from Maple Avenue to its northwesterly terminus, shown on Exhibit A of the Bureau of Engineering (BOE) report dated June 12, 2018 (attached to the Council file), be initiated pursuant to California Streets and Highways Code, Division 9, Part 3, Public Streets, Highways and Service Easements Vacation Law.
2. INSTRUCT the BOE to process this vacation request under Council file Nos. 02-1979 and 18-0559, Engineering Work Order No. E1401212.
3. INSTRUCT the BOE to investigate the feasibility of this vacation request.
4. INSTRUCT the BOE to report to the Public Safety Committee regarding the feasibility of vacating the requested area.
5. INSTRUCT the City Clerk to coordinate and schedule this request for the Public Safety Committee's consideration at the appropriate time consistent with the public hearing requirements under California Street and Highways Code, Section 8320.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The BOE reports that a fee of \$14,980 was paid by the petitioner for the investigation of this request pursuant to Section 7.42 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code (LAAC). Any deficit fee to recover the cost pursuant to Section 7.44 of the LAAC will be required of the petitioner.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At a regular meeting held on September 5, 2018, the Public Safety Committee considered a BOE report regarding initiating vacation proceedings for 21st Street southerly of Washington Boulevard from Maple Avenue to its northwesterly terminus. After an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended on consent to approve the recommendations in the BOE report. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
