TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to increasing the Bureau of Engineering's (BOE) application for Better Utilizing Investments to Leverage Development (BUILD) grant funding for the Los Angeles River Valley Bikeway Greenway Design Completion Project.

Recommendation for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

AMEND the Council action taken July 3, 2018 relative to the Bureau of Engineering's application for BUILD grant funding from the United States Department of Transportation for the Los Angeles River Valley Bikeway Greenway Design Completion Project, as follows:

SUMMARY

In a report to Council dated August 6, 2018, the City Engineer recommends that Council amend its action taken July 3, 2018, to increase the Bureau of Engineering's application for BUILD grant funding from \$9,000,000 to \$12,000,000 from the United States Department of Transportation for the Los Angeles River Valley Bikeway Greenway Design Completion Project. The City Engineer states that the anticipated request from the BUILD program was \$9,000,000 with two sources of matching funds: \$3,000,000 from Metro and \$3,000,000 from Los Angeles County, as sourced from a development agreement with NBC Universal. Subsequent to Council approval of the grant request, staff determined that the \$3,000,000 match from Los Angeles County was not eligible for this use.

At its meeting held August 22, 2018, the Transportation Committee recommended that Council approve the City Engineer's recommendation to increase its application for BUILD grant fundning.
