

## ADOPTED BUDGET RECOMMENDATION

Instruct the City Planning Department to report to the Planning and Land Use Management Committee and the Energy, Climate Change, and Environmental Justice Committee on the cost to prepare a State-sanctioned climate action plan, whether the Department has performed a climate change risk assessment, and what resources could be secured, should such a plan be in place. The report should include the possible impacts of climate change on the City, such as rising sea level, and the Department's efforts to reduce the impact of climate change, including the following climate scenarios under which the City: (a) continues business as usual; (b) has slow incremental progress on emissions reductions; and (c) drastically ramps up efforts, moves its goals 10 years sooner, and inspires other cities to replicate the City's efforts.
