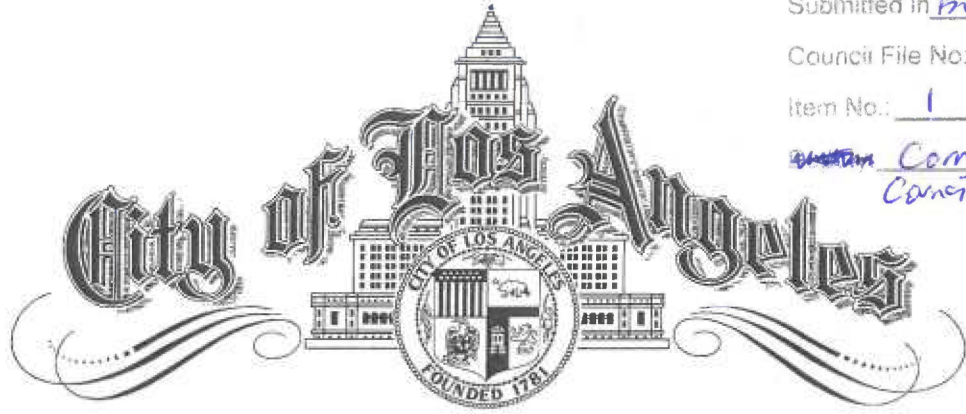

Re: CF 16-0600 Mayor's Proposed Budget FY 2018-2019

Councilmember Krekorian,

There are two key programs integral to Council District 8 that have not been met in the proposed budget that I would like to request that the CLA assist in finding funding for: Destination Crenshaw & a C3 team for outreach services.

Destination Crenshaw (the project) is a 1.1-mile long outdoor art museum along Crenshaw Boulevard to commemorate and celebrate African American history and culture in Los Angeles. Council District 8 is requesting funding in the amount of \$125,000 for Bureau of Engineering (BOE) staff for fiscal year 2018-2019. The funding will cover services including: project oversight and review of reports and plans, to verify compliance with the City standards and requirements. The project will be going through a B-Permit/Revocable permit with the guidance of BOE staff to ensure the project timeline is executed on-time and on-budget. Pre-construction project timeline is as follows:

- 1. Schematic Design (May 2018)
- 2. Design Drawings (June 2018)
- 3. Construction Drawings (August/September 2018)

Council District 8 has a C3 team that focuses on prevention, engagement with our homeless Angelenos and most importantly directing them into housing with services. \$250,000 is needed to fund this team.
