Comments for Public Posting: Regarding pgs. 21 & 22 of the CEQA Notice of Exemption for the

BRIDGE HOUSING ON 515 or 417, 427, 433 N. BEACON STREET (CF 18-0651-S3): Residents along 322 -540 N. PV ST, at the top of the steep slope above the proposed Bridge Home, have recently noticed new cracks & separation of their cement & tiles. We felt significant vibrations lasting all day, more than a block away. Residents thought it was earthquakes & were so strong it awakened them. Homeowners at Habitat for Humanity, across & on the south side of OFarrell St. from the proposed site at the top of the hill, more than a block away from the recent construction in the CalTrans property, felt vibrations. At least one household there had their automatic earthquake gas regulator automatically turn off once a month, 3-4 times. "There was always noise in windows & doors & the dishes in the kitchen. All day there was vibration", from October 2018 until April 2019. There are many photos of new cracks in curbs & widening of the original swale. Unfortunately, this website does not allow photos.
