Brand these available parking lots as designated SAFE PARKING LA sites and reach out to those living in cars throughout the city, letting them know of the availability of SAFE PARKING LA sites. We will work with law enforcement for a 'grace period' and instead of waking up a family sleeping in a car or an RV and telling them to move, we will, instead, provide a Safe Parking LA map to the windshield of the vehicle.

Safe Parking LA will create gathering points – parking lots around the city currently unused during evening hours - as a place to safely park. These gathering points will include faith based organizations, such as churches and synagogues and privately owned business parking lots, unused from 7p to 7a most days. Each site will serve the purpose of providing social services to this community in need as a step towards ending homelessness.

Yes, they have finally been moved out and the locals thought they would have peace and a safe environment. This site is next to a ballfield and two historic monuments. Is this the way to encourage visitors to the community to enjoy the Civil War locations? Is this what you see when you visit other historic sites?

Besides, where will the participants of the program go during the day? Into the neighborhood most likely.

That said, why not use land east of Alameda, and/or in the Industrial Park which would help those areas improve by having the City finally enforce ordinances. Thank you for the information. However I do not support bridge housing on Eubank Ave in Wilmington. I feel the reason the homeless gather in Wilmington is due to: urban blight from lack of public services, tolerance from LAPD, and because our government officials do not listen to home owners concerns having mentally ill people, drug addicts, criminals etc... free to degrade our quality of life.

I also believe city officials take advantage of Wilmington because it is a small section of district 15 and an even smaller part of LA City with limited voting power.

Wilmington already has resources for homeless and to propose a tent or a temporary trailer encampment is unacceptable.

From a personal economic perspective would you pay taxes on a \$400,000 home next to a homeless encampment? You and those proposing this know our home values will decrease yet our tax base will remain. This is completely unfair.

Also Southern California is a very expensive place to live. Is it realistic to think city officials can support homeless people to the point of self sufficiency? Sadly I don't believe so. I completely believe our community will be over run with people that have deep problems that are beyond our/city officials capabilities.

I oppose the proposed bridge housing on Eubank Ave in Wilmington. This is a issue for the state of California to figure out and I suggest building homeless encampments away from residential neighborhoods and placing these facilities on undeveloped State land. Allowing more time for these troubled individuals to become self sufficient, receive mental care, become rehabilitated from drug and alcohol addiction and to learn necessarily life skills, which takes time and professional services. We the residents and property owners deserve to live in peace and to protect our property values, our single largest investment.

Dear Councilmembers:

We understand that homelessness is a major issue in our City. It should not however, be the responsibility of one community to be responsible for the homeless for an entire District. Sadly, this is exactly what is being proposed. I have enclosed a copy of the Map from Safeparkingla.org. Per the information on this website and provided by LAPD this is the map that our LAPD officers are using today. As you can see the green areas are where it is legal for homeless in their vehicles to park. If they are outside that area they are given a Map of where to park legally. You can see Wilmington has more green areas than San Pedro, Harbor City and Harbor Gateway COMBINED. On top of this, our community is being vetted for a Bridge Home in addition to a large lot for vehicles. If the responsibility is to be spread equally then other communities need to step up and share the burden.

From looking at how these green streets are set up it appears as if the City is exasperating the homeless situation in Wilmington because the City is actually giving our homeless a map and telling them if you cannot find room on the 3 or 4 blocks of where you are currently located there is plenty of room in Wilmington. As opposed to addressing the issue where it lies in the communities where they reside.

It is apparent from the map the burden is NOT being shared equally among the District and it's also conspicuously obvious that the area where our Councilman lives there is NOT A SINGLE Street where he or his neighbors would accommodate our homeless.

Unlike the other communities being vetted we are the only community to have ALL the following:

- Wilmington already has 3 homeless shelters, as well as transitional living and we support our homeless with meals, showers, medical care and food
- We already have a church that allows someone in their RV to stay on the property, and this is without pay from the City and Prior to the City making any suggestions.
- The property is in a Methane Zone
- We are only one of three Communities in the City of Los Angeles that have clean up-green up zones
- We are the ONLY community that sits on the coastline but are not given access to the ocean.
- We are surrounded by refineries on Three Sides

- We accommodate the Intermodal Ship to Rail
- We accommodate the Alameda Corridor

Furthermore, it is our understanding that the lot being proposed in San Pedro is a Park and Ride lot. Owned by Caltrans and Federally Funded. Per Caltrans the City would have to change the zoning and go to court in order to utilize this lot. Something that Caltrans does not see happening when you call their District Office. It is our belief, that our Councilman is just suggesting this property as a Prop to make it appear that there will be something in San Pedro on a longer term basis. Although some Churches in San Pedro may host RV's; per our understanding at any time these Churches can withdraw from the program thus exempting the community of San Pedro from being FORCED to accommodate the homeless as Wilmington would be. Meanwhile in Wilmington where we have had homeless shelters, provide food, meals and medical care to our homeless and already have a church hosting an RV's our efforts remain unnoticed.

Wilmington is being put on an unlevelled playing field. We are an extremely small community by Los Angeles standards. Wilmington simply is overburdened and to ask us to shoulder MORE is grossly unfair. Our Councilman should be leading by example and remove the red line out of his residential area and allow the RV's to park there. Perhaps when he has lead his community by example than our community would be more amendable.

We would also like it noted for the record that on numerous occasions we have reached out to our Councilman and requested a meeting to help reach a resolution that is both fair and equitable. As of this writing our Councilman has refused to meet with any members of our community as other Councilmen have done. Also on August 1, 2018 at the Committee Meeting on Homeless and Poverty we submitted approximately 1000 petitions and asked that they be placed into the record . As of this date we have yet to see these items placed into the official record of CF 18-0651 and ask again that they do so. We also will be submitting several hundred more petitions today

We thank you for your consideration in this matter and Our community respectfully requests that you reconsider the Wilmington location.
