PROJECT SCOPE

I am a licensed professional Civil Engineer with over 34 years of work experience with the Department of Public Works in both the Bureaus of Engineering and Sanitation; in the Bureau of Engineering, I have 20 years' experience in the design and construction management of street, storm drain, and sewer projects. I am a Principal Civil Engineer and currently serve as Division Engineer, in the Bureau of Engineering's Sidewalk Division, managing the Sidewalk Repair Program undertaking work required by the Willits Settlement Agreement (SRP). I have 12 months experience working with City sidewalk repairs in conjunction with the SRP and, in that time, I estimate I have been involved with 100+ plans for separate sidewalk repairs. The Bureau of Engineering – Sidewalk Division manages the design, construction management, and implementation of the SRP for the City of Los Angeles. The SRP has repaired over 60 miles of sidewalks since 2015.

This sidewalk repair Project is similar in kind and size to other sidewalk repairs undertaken by the City with which I am familiar and does not involve significantly unique construction methods or involve circumstances different than involved with sidewalk repairs generally.
