

MOTION

In 2007, the City of Los Angeles received approval from the State Office of Historic Preservation and the National Park Service as a "Certified Local Government" for historic preservation. This status validates that the City has in place the elements of a comprehensive historic preservation program and makes the City eligible for grants from the State Office of Historic Preservation.


At least ten percent of California's yearly allocation of federal funds received through the Historic Preservation Fund Grants Program under the National Historic Preservation Act must be sub-granted to Certified Local Governments. On August 2, 2018 the Department of City Planning, Office of Historic Resources was selected as one of the local governments in California to receive a *2018-19 Certified Local Government Grant*; the grant amount is \$36,000.

The grant funds will be used to assist the Office of Historic Resources with tasks associated with the integration of historic resources data into HistoricPlacesLA, the online historic resources inventory and management system. The proposed project includes data from SurveyLA, surveys completed by other City agencies, and designation data for properties listed under local, state, and national designation programs. All expenses for work to be performed must be incurred within the period of October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2019.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council:

1. **AUTHORIZE** the Director of Planning or designee, subject to the approval of the Mayor, to take the following actions:
 - a. Enter into a project agreement (contract) with the State Office of Historic Preservation, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality, to accept a grant in the amount of \$36,000 which will be used to integrate historic resources data into HistoricPlacesLA, requiring that all expenses for work to be performed be incurred within the period of October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2019.
 - b. Set up a grant receivable of \$36,000 and establish an appropriation account within the City Planning Grant Trust Fund No. 46Y/68 for the disbursement of funds for the project.
 - c. Submit grant reimbursement requests to the State Office of Historic Preservation and deposit grant receipts in the City Planning Grants Trust Fund No. 46Y.
2. **AUTHORIZE** the City Administrative Officer to make any technical corrections to the above fund transfer instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this motion.
