## TO CITY CLERK FOR PLACEMENT ON NEXT REGULAR COUNCIL AGENDA TO BE POSTED

Griffith Park is one of the nation's largest urban parks, spanning over 4,200 acres of both natural covered terrain and landscaped parkland with picnic areas. Griffith Park offers numerous family attractions, educational and cultural opportunities, miles of hiking and horseback trails, and provides recreational space for park visitors. Griffith Park's popularity attracts over 10 million annual visitors, many of whom bring, or purchase, beverages and food while touring the park for physical activity and recreational purposes. While some recycling activities occur at particular locations within the park, such as the Greek Theatre and the Los Angeles Zoo, the vast majority of the non-ticketed park areas do not contain recycling receptacles.

On July 17, 2018, the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) launched the Beverage Container Recycling Grant Program. On August 7, 2018, the Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP) applied for this grant program to prepare and implement a pilot beverage container recycling program in Griffith Park. If awarded, funding provided by the Beverage Container Recycling Grant Program would enable RAP to operate a recycling pilot program at various high foot-traffic areas of Griffith Park to provide the City with a better understanding of overall recycling service needs within parks and to offer park visitors the opportunity to recycle in areas of Griffith Park that currently do not have recycling receptacles.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Department of Recreation and Parks be requested / authorized to submit a grant application to the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) for the Beverage Container Recycling Grant Program to be used for the Griffith Park Pilot Recycling Program; that the attached Resolution required by the State granting agency be adopted, which authorizes the City of Los Angeles to apply for this grant and authorizes the Department of Recreation and Parks to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including, but not limited to grant applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests, and all other action pertaining to this grant in order to effectuate the participation in the Fiscal Year 2019-21 grant cycle.

I FURTHER MOVE that upon award and acceptance of the grant, the Department of Recreation and Parks be requested to report with the details of how this grant will be implemented.

WHEREAS, in furtherance of this authority, CalRecycle is required to establish procedures governing the application, awarding, and management of the grants; and

WHEREAS, the CalRecycle grant application procedures require, among other things, an applicant's governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of CalRecycle grants;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Los Angeles authorizes the submittal of an application to CalRecycle for the Beverage Container Recycling Grant Program Fiscal Year 2018-19 and 2019-20; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED RAP's General Manager, Executive Officer, or Assistant General Managers are hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of the City of Los Angeles Department of Recreation and Parks all grant documents, including but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments and requests for payment, necessary to secure grant funds and implement the approved grant project; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** these authorizations are effective for five (5) years from the date of adoption of this resolution.
