MOTION

Council District 13 has received a request to donate a surplus vehicle to Clínica Romero, a 501(c)(3) tax-exempt non-profit operating clinic with two sites in the City.

Section 22.547 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code provides that upon Council approval, surplus City equipment may be sold for less than market value to a non-profit organization located in the City of Los Angeles which has been established exclusively to further the services provided by the City and its departments. Clínica Romero is located at 123 South Alvarado Street, 90057, and 2032 Marengo Street, 90033. The donation of one (1) passenger van will further Clínica Romero's mission of providing quality, affordable, culturally-sensitive health care to underserved communities of Los Angeles by allowing the non-profit to transport patients and members. The fair market value of the van is \$4000, which will be foregone revenue should it be donated.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council:

- 1. Find that Clínica Romero is eligible to purchase one 1997 Ford E250 Passenger Van (VIN# 1FBHE31L5VHC01405) at below market value (\$1.00), in accordance with LAAC Section 22.547 (Donation of Surplus City Equipment), as the recipient is a non-profit organization that has been established exclusively to further the services provided by the City; and
- 2. Request the City Attorney prepare a contract to effectuate the sale and transfer of the above identified surplus equipment at below market value to Clínica Romero; and
- 3. Instruct the City Clerk to inform Clínica Romero [Stephanie Lemus, 123 South Alvarado Street, Los Angeles, CA 90057, (213) 318-8914] that the surplus equipment must be claimed within 60 days from the date of Council approval of the request after which time it will revert to the City's surplus equipment pool for disposal by the Department of General Services.
