Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to (Wesson - Koretz):

1. REQUEST the Board of Recreation and Parks (Board) to name the new playground located within the Jim Gilliam Recreation Center at 4000 South La Brea Avenue as the Julius Phillips Playground.
2. REQUEST the Board to name the new splash pad located within the Recreation Center as the Gregory Horn Splash Pad.
