HOMELESSNESS AND POVERTY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to evaluating the property at 741 Gayley Avenue for possible development as a crisis and bridge housing facility.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Koretz - Blumenfield):

- INSTRUCT the City Administrative Officer (CAO), with the assistance of the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), the Bureau of Engineering, the Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority, and any other affected City stakeholders, to evaluate the property at 741 Gayley Avenue to determine if the property is suitable for development as a crisis and bridge housing facility.
- INSTRUCT the City Homeless Coordinator, if the property is determined to be suitable for development as a crisis and bridge housing facility, to coordinate with the Los Angeles County to identify funds for operations at the sites, including, but not limited to County Measure H revenue.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At a special meeting held on November 21, 2018, the Homelessness and Poverty Committee considered Motion (Koretz - Blumenfield) regarding the property at 741 Gayley Avenue as a crisis and bridge housing facility. After an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended on consent to approve the Motion. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
