

HOMELESSNESS AND POVERTY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the evaluation of the properties at 5533 South Western Avenue and 5525 South Western Avenue as crisis and bridge housing facilities.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Harris-Dawson - Cedillo):

1. INSTRUCT the City Administrative Officer (CAO), with the assistance of the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), the Bureau of Engineering, Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority, and any other affected City stakeholders, to evaluate the properties at 5533 South Western Avenue and 5525 South Western Avenue to determine if the properties are suitable for development as crisis and bridge housing facilities.
2. INSTRUCT the City Homeless Coordinator, if the properties are determined to be suitable for development as crisis and bridge housing facility, to coordinate with Los Angeles County to identify funds for operations at the sites, including, but not limited to County Measure H revenue.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At its regular meeting held on January 16, 2019, the Homelessness and Poverty Committee considered Motion (Harris-Dawson - Cedillo) relative to the evaluation of the properties at 5533 South Western Avenue and 5525 South Western Avenue as crisis and bridge housing facilities.
