The law firm of Remy Moose Manley, a City contractor, is assisting the City Attorney to defend the City against lawsuits challenging on environmental grounds the City's Interim Motel Conversion Ordinance and Permanent Supportive Housing Ordinance, both of which are important tools in the City's efforts to address the homeless crisis.

To assist in this effort, the United Way has offered to contribute \$50,000 directly to the law firm of Remy, Moose, Manley LLP on behalf of the City for paralegal support necessary to defend these ordinances.


