

HOMELESSNESS AND POVERTY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the evaluation of the properties at 442 South San Pedro Street, 2426 East Washington Boulevard, 606 East 6th Street, and 540 Towne Avenue as crisis bridge housing and/or other crisis response facilities.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Huizar - Harris-Dawson):

1. INSTRUCT the City Administrative Officer (CAO), with the assistance of the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), Bureau of Engineering, Los Angeles Homeless Service Authority, and any other City department or affected stakeholder as necessary, to evaluate the properties at 442 South San Pedro Street, 2426 East Washington Boulevard, 606 East 6th Street, and 540 Towne Avenue to determine their suitability for providing crisis bridge housing and/or other crisis response facilities.
2. AUTHORIZE the Department of General Services to identify an on-site homeless services operator, negotiate the terms of a lease with potential service providers, and to report to Council on these actions.
3. INSTRUCT the City Homeless Coordinator, if the properties are determined to be suitable as crisis bridge housing and/or as a crisis response facility, to coordinate with Los Angeles County to identify funds for operation at the sites, including, but not limited to County Measure H revenue.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At its regular meeting held on January 16, 2019, the Homelessness and Poverty Committee considered Motion (Huizar - Harris-Dawson) relative to the evaluation of the properties at properties at 442 South San Pedro Street, 2426 East Washington Boulevard, 606 East 6th Street, and 540 Towne Avenue as crisis bridge housing and/or other crisis response facilities.
