

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to assembling a Wildland-Urban Interface Hazard Mitigation Task Force.

Recommendation for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Bonin - Ryu - et al.):

DIRECT the Los Angeles Fire Department and Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), in consultation with the Los Angeles Police Department, Emergency Management Department, Department of Transportation, Department of Recreation and Parks, Department of Animal Services, Information Technology Agency, Department of Neighborhood Empowerment, Department of Building and Safety, Department of City Planning, Department of Water and Power and any other internal or external partners, to report on issues related to hazard mitigation efforts and goals in the Wildland-Urban Interface. This report should include an outline of the scope of work and objectives for each Department with responsibilities in this area.
