

RULES, ELECTIONS, AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to establishing the City's position regarding the Federal Aviation Administration's (FAA) proposed amendments to two existing departure routes from Hollywood Burbank Airport.

Recommendation for Council action, as initiated by Resolution (Ryu - Krekorian - Koretz), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying revised RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2019-20 Federal Legislative Program, OPPOSITION to the proposed OROSZ THREE and SLAPP TWO amended departure routes for Hollywood Burbank Airport and the FAA Draft Environmental Review's Finding of *No Significant Impact* under the National Environmental Policy Act.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At a special meeting held on December 11, 2018, the Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered Resolution (Ryu - Krekorian - Koretz) and a CLA report relative to establishing the City's position regarding the FAA's proposed amendments to two existing departure routes from Hollywood Burbank Airport.

During consideration of the matter, a revised Resolution was submitted that includes revisions such as identifying the departure routes and clarifying that the City's position on the matter should be included as part of its 2019-20 Federal Legislative Program. The CLA report and the revised Resolution, attached to the Council file, provide additional background information.

After consideration, and after providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council adopt the revised Resolution. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
