HOMELESSNESS AND POVERTY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to evaluation of the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) property located at 5874 Miramonte Boulevard as a Crisis and Bridge Housing Program facility.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Wesson for Price - Harris-Dawson):

- INSTRUCT the City Administrative Officer (CAO), with the assistance of the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), Bureau of Engineering, Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority, and any other affected City stakeholders, to work with the LADWP to evaluate the site located at 5874 Miramonte Boulevard to determine if the property is suitable for development as a Crisis and Bridge Housing Program facility.
- INSTRUCT the City Homeless Coordinator, if the property is determined to be suitable for development as a Crisis and Bridge Housing Program facility, to coordinate with Los Angeles County to identify funds for operations at the site, including, but not limited to, County Measure H revenue.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: Neither the CAO nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At its regular meeting held on January 16, 2019, the Homelessness and Poverty Committee considered Motion (Wesson for Price - Harris-Dawson) relative to the evaluation of the LADWP-owned property at 5874 Miramonte Boulevard as a Crisis and Bridge Housing Program Facility.
