Prior to Airbnb I was on welfare and medical and borrowing money left and right, I wasn't able to find a job. Before I used to make a good living and i was ready to take any jobs going down considerably on salary. Who want to hire a 64 old women. Can minimum wages pay your bills when you have a mortgage even do cheaper than renting, home insurance, Real estate taxes, car insurance, health insurance which for my age is closed to \$1100 a month without cover California + co payment+ 20%....and debt and living in Los Angeles. Absolutely not. Then when i will be 65, the amount of money i will get from social security will not be able enough to pay 1/4 of my expenses. selling my property? most money will go to the taxes with what is left, how long can i live with it..... So thank G od for Airbnb, i found some dignity even it is to only pay my bills. no more welfare, no more medical and most of all no more medication for depression. It felt good again to be able to take care of myself. so please do not take that away from me, from us. thank you
